

Infrastructure, Equipment & Facilities

The Royal Institute of Para-medical Sciences, College of nursing has excellent infrastructure which makes students learn in a conducive atmosphere.

Building

Spacious, well ventilated building, constructed as per the norms of Indian nursing council with adequate lecture halls, laboratories, staff room etc. An excellent facility which is fully equipped with latest educational technology including smart board system. The same facility is used for various discussions and other programmes.

Class rooms / Lecture Halls

Adequate number of spacious, well ventilated, lecture halls with comfortable seating arrangements equipped with traditional & modern teaching aids like black board, LCD projectors and Over head projector are available.

Staff rooms

Well equipped and ventilated rooms for principal, faculty and staff are available.

Laboratory Facilities

Well - equipped laboratories offer best learning facilities to develop the technical skills through practical demonstrations before the students have clinical practice on patients.

Nursing Foundation Lab

Students are trained in Basic Nursing procedures & Advanced procedures. This lab consists of cots with mattresses, charts, mannequins, advanced Nursing Models, instruments & articles necessary for procedure demonstration.

Anatomy Lab

Spacious, ventilated & well equipped with seating arrangements and charts, posters, models.

Computer Lab

This lab is well equipped with latest computers having internet facilities useful for students for Research activities. A provision is made to access e-journals also.

Child Health Nursing Lab

Students are trained in Advanced procedures and skills related to the specialty. This lab consists of cots with mattresses, charts, mannequins, advanced Nursing Models, instruments & articles necessary for procedure demonstration.

Community Health Nursing Lab

Spacious, ventilated & well equipped with seating arrangements and charts, posters, models, health education plans. Health folders & records related to services provided to the adopted villages are maintained by students.

Nutrition Lab:

This lab is well equipped which facilitates students to learn to prepare various kinds of therapeutic diets.







Students are trained in Advanced procedures and skills related to the specialty. This lab consists of cot with mattress, charts, mannequins, delivery model, instruments & articles necessary for midwifery procedure demonstration.

Auditorium

Spacious, well ventilated with seating arrangements and equipped AV aids such as LCD projector, T V etc. It is used for conducting various academic and non-academic programmes.

AVAid Room

It is well equipped with various kinds of audio visual aids such as charts, posters, DVDs, VCDs, CDs & cassettes necessary for purpose of teaching, presentations, seminars, demonstrations, workshops and other group activities.

Examination Hall

Spacious, well ventilated and equipped with seating arrangements in examination hall is used for conducting various exams.

Library Facilities

College is having a spacious, well ventilated and equipped library in the campus. The library is computerized with rich collection of latest reference books, journals, periodicals, newspapers, magazines and e-journals. There is a computer lab with internet facility.

Faculty

Admission

The candidates on the final merit list of BOPEE selected for the Institution must complete the admission by paying the fee latest by the cut of date fixed by the BOPEE/ institution every year. Seat once allotted to candidate by BOPEE & from the start-up of classes cannot be cancelled and accordingly no refund of fee shall be claimed.

FEE Structure

The fee consists of Tuition fee /University Registration fee/ University Affiliation fee/ Document processing charges / Other charges i.e. Library/laboratory fee, Sports, teaching aids, Wi-fy and the student shall have to clear the same within the stipulated period of time otherwise shall attract late fee charges.

Hospital Training/Clinical Fees

The student shall have to pay Hospital Training/ Clinical fees as may be fixed by the Government to the SSH/ Govt. Hospital/DH/ SDH in which the student would undergo training from time to time as prescribed in syllabus.

Uniform

The student shall have to follow a proper dress code as per norms laid down by the Government/Nurses Council of India.
